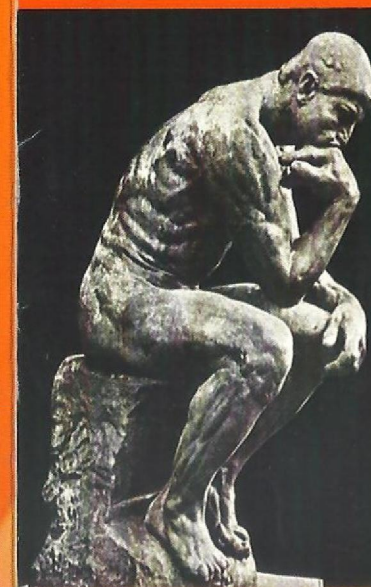

He is also the recipient of Corresponding Membership Award of American Society for Plant Biology, 2010, the first time to an Indian. He has to his credit 200 Research publications in important National and International Journals; 13 edited books and 50 chapters in various books. He has travelled widely, participating in various National and International Seminars, Conferences and Workshops.

Dr. Harish Chaudhry has done his schooling from The Doon School, Dehradun, holds a B.Tech from IIT Kanpur, PGDBM from IIM Bangalore and a Ph D. He is an Assistant Professor of Marketing Management. He has worked for Dunlop and NIIT before shifting to the academics. He has taken up major consultancy projects with many organizations like Godfrey Philips and served as Director of a Home Appliance Company. Dr. Chaudhry is a consultant and trainer of repute to corporate sector. Having carried a substantial research on values and quality in education, he has conducted numerous training programmes for school Principals, parents and teachers.

Chitra Ravi Founder & CEO, EZ Vidya Pvt. Ltd, Chennai is a management graduate and has a great passion for education. Schools in India, particularly in the private sector have been raising a different kind of inclusiveness where creativity, logical thinking and innovation find an important place right from kindergarten.
