Prof. Chatterjee has been instrumental in giving one of India's premiere institutions, IIM Kozhikode, a socially sensitive, gender friendly and innovative facelift. He has done pioneering work by personally training thousands of K-12 school teachers from underprivileged schools. He has more than 100 publications, monographs and articles, in addition to five books, to his credit.

Prof. Chatterjee's published work in the field of leadership and his world class research contribution in the converging space of spirituality and leadership have been critically acclaimed and highly applauded.

Dr. Vinayshil Gautam, M.A., Ph.D., FRAS is the first Head and a Professor at the Department of Management Studies of Indian Institute of Technology, New Delhi. He is a widely respected consultant and practitioner of Management Studies in India and abroad. Having designed and set up the Comparative Management Research programme in Asia, he has contributed to management studies, entrepreneurship and has initiated venture efforts in the institute.

Dr. Gautam has been the Chairman of the All India Board of Management Education and has addressed international audiences at prominent universities in a number of cities across the globe. Dr. Gautam is the recipient of many national and international honors including the G-51 Millennium Award, Bharat Gaurav Award, Shiksha Ratan Puraskar, DMA Achievement Award and the Royal Asiatic Society.

Professor Rama Matthews is currently the Dean of the Department of Education, University of Delhi and is presently coordinating the English Language Proficiency Course for the students of Delhi University. She has been an active participant in quality enhancement of education in Indian institutions. Apart from the University of Delhi, she has been an instructor for twenty years at the Central Institute of English and Foreign Languages, Hyderabad where her specific focus was on language teacher education and assessment.

She has been an invited plenary speaker at several conferences in India and other countries including the conference of the International Association of Teachers of English as a Foreign Language (IATEFL) at Liverpool, UK in 2004, considered to be the largest association of teachers in the world. She has penned down various research papers on Teacher Education and English Language Teaching. Her current research interests include teaching English to adult learners, teacher education, proficiency assessment including online assessment..

Dr. Chand Kiran Saluja is a post-graduate in Sanskrit, Hindi, Political Science, English and Education with an M.Phil and L.L.B degree. He is presently an associate professor at the Central Institute of Education, Department of Education, University of Delhi.

He has been a Member of the Governing Body of CBSE, a Member of CBSE International, a Convener of Sanskrit Curriculum Committee, CBSE, and an Advisor of Sanskrit books for Samskrit Bharati (USA). He has been a guide and mentor to a large number of students and trained them for their M.Phil and Ph. D programmes. He has written six books on education, two on Sanskrit grammar, ten CBSE textbooks and teachers' handbook and has edited three books for PCD Trust on Education. Dr. saluja coordinated the publication of several Sanskrit books and Sanskrit materials for Samskrit Bharati. Under the MHRD Project, he has also been an advisor on the panel for self-learning Sanskrit materials.
